

National Census of Agriculture and Livestock 2006/07 Main Report

The National Census of Agriculture and Livestock is the fourth census of Agriculture to be conducted in Malawi, the last being that of 1991/92 National Sample Survey of Agriculture (NSSA). It is part of a concerted effort by government to provide relevant information on the structure of agriculture in the country, especially in view of its importance to the economy. The census was designed to collect information on different aspects of smallholder agriculture including crops grown, area planted and production, land husbandry practices, food security, marketing and structure of the small holder sector.
